Good afternoon Johnston families and staff, this is Dr. DiLullo with updates for today. As I stated in my earlier call to you tomorrow April 3 and Friday April 17 will be counted as school days but teachers and teacher assistants will be in training and planning sessions and not available virtually. Students may receive assignments from their teachers on these dates so students should log into their Google classroom to see if any assignments have been posted. According to the Rhode Island Department of Education all students will be marked present for these two days so it is not necessary to submit the attendance form. Office staff scheduled to work on odd days should be at work on April 3 and 17 as well as these are considered regular work days. Next week will be a three day school week with school holidays on Thursday and Friday. These are days off for all students and school staff. For elementary parents, we would like to update your email addresses as we plan to give you access to the parent portal on ASPEN in the future. This will allow you to see your student's progress and access to report cards in grades 1-5. Kindergarten and preschool report cards will still be hard copies. The electronic form can be accessed on our district website at [johnstonschools.org](http://johnstonschools.org). Go to the schools tab and on the pull down menu go to the Pre-k Kindergarten Elementary Schools tab. Click on the tab and then on the Email request form. Fill out the form and click submit. We will receive the form electronically and update your information. I want to remind all of our students to follow the Governor's guidelines for this month and not gather with more than 5 people and remember to constantly wash your hands and stay away from anyone who appears to be sick. Keep a distance of 6 feet at all times between you and another person. This is critical to slow and stop the spread of the virus. As always thank you for your cooperation and support during this time and have a pleasant evening and weekend.
