Good afternoon Johnston families, this is Dr. DiLullo with a few updates. First a reminder that Friday April 3rd will be a district instructional planning day so teachers and teacher assistants will not be on line on that day but will be participating in training and planning. This will also occur on April 17. April 9th and 10th have been deemed school holidays by the Governor so there will be no assignments or instruction on either of those dates. Starting tomorrow April 2nd, children no longer need to be present to be given a meal. Parents and Guardians picking up meals for children not present will be required to identify the students they are picking up for and which school they attend. Our food service will continue to provide meals no questions asked if the children are present. Also beginning on Friday April 3rd, the location of the High School pickup will be relocated to the rear of the building instead of the front. There is an entry way from Atwood Avenue to access the rear of the High School building. Pick up times for meals remain the same, 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM. Once again thank you for all you are doing for our students and for your patience in these difficult days. Stay well and have a good rest of your day.
